



If you do not have a JTDI account, select Register.




USG Warning and Consent Banner

JTDI user account expiration notice: IAW DoD Cyber Security Policy, JTDI users must log into the JTDI portal at least once every 90 days. Accounts that reach 90 days of inactivity will be suspended. If 45 days elapse since the last account activity, the account will be deleted. Users that have their account deleted will be required to re-register if access is still required. Additionally, JTDI users are required to update/confirm their registration information annually. Registration information can be updated/confirmed at any time by selecting the "Update Registration Info" link, which is located within the Support area on the right side of each JTDI website. Accounts that are not updated/confirmed annually will be deleted.




