



The S3I Directorate at Redstone Arsenal, Huntsville Alabama, manages the Automated Weight & Balance System (AWBS) software. Our AWBS team supports the whole of Army aviation to include the following:

- Help Desk support for Active Army, National Guard, and Reserve
- Develop and maintain AWBS software references and training materials
- Travel to unit locations to provide software training and database support
- Maintain the AWBS JTDI webpage
- Represents the Army during Joint Service IPT meetings for software issues, concerns, and suggestions

Our training focuses on the AWBS Software and we do not qualify Weight and Balance Technicians IAW AR 95-1, paragraph 7-2. Your commander can use our Course as part of a training program to designate Weight and Balance Technicians IAW AR 95-1.

What our AWBS software training provides:

- AWBS software Overview
- Create and Manage an AWBS DATABASE
 - Import and Export of aircraft and Form F
 - Create an aircraft
 - Database management
- Chart A functions in AWBS / Master Chart A creation and use
- Modification Wizard
- Form B Functions in AWBS (Weighing Worksheet)
- Chart C Functions in AWBS
- Form F Functions in AWBS

AWBS Training is no cost to the requesting organization, and is a one day course. If you want two classes we can accommodate and stay an additional day. If you want assistance with your unit AWBS Program we can also stay an additional day to assist you.

AWBS training can accommodate up to 20 personnel in one class. We do require a classroom with seating and a desk for each Student. Each student is provided a training workstation. We will need AC power and screen for projection or a monitor to display the training materials. We ask that you reach out to your surrounding area and see if you have others that may want to attend AWBS training. Once this is published on the AWBS calendar, others may contact the AWBS team for attendance. We will coordinate with you if we have any other personnel requesting training in your area.
