## **Needing Condition Code Tags**

## An Easy Outline for Sergeant's Time Training

**Problem**: What are the colors and form numbers for condition code tags?

**Solution**: The yellow tag is DD Form 1574; the red tag is DD Form 1577; the green tag is DD Form

1577-2; and the blue tag is DD Form 1576.

Problem: What is each color tag used for?

Solution:

- The yellow tag, DD Form 1574, is for a repaired component sent back to you from the aviation support battalion (ASB) or depot.
- The red tag, DD Form 1577, is for unserviceable or condemned components.
- The green tag, DD Form 1577-2, is for a component that needs service or repair by an ASB or depot.
- The blue tag, DD Form 1576, is for a component scheduled for non-destructive inspection (NDI) or testing.

**Problem:** How can condition code tags be ordered by NSN?

**Solution:** Condition code tags cannot be order by NSN through the supply system. Order them through the Army Media Distribution Division (MDD).

**Problem:** How do unit production and control personnel order condition code tags?

**Solution:** Order condition code tags through the Army Media Distribution Division (MDD). To set up an account, email the MDD customer service help desk at:
